**Student Chapter Advisory Committee Report**

November 8, 2022

Dear CPFI Board of Directors:

We pray this finds you all well as we continue to transition back to our new “normal.” In brief, our report includes follow up on old business we have not heard back on since the last board meeting, updates in the leadership of the National Student Council (NSC), ongoing/completed activities, and our future goals for the SCAC.

Updates in Leadership: Current Officers

Ongoing/Competed Activities

- Attend the monthly NSC meetings as our schedule permits
- Serve as a contact point and support for the NSC officers
- Provide support to student chapters and respond to questions via email
- Conduct SCAC committee meetings every 2-4 months

Together we have accomplished the following tasks since the summer:

- For the CPFI Hands and Feet Grants:
  - Available funds raised from the silent auction to grant up to sixteen \$500 grants.
  - Updated the 2022-2023 Hands and Feet application to include:
    - setting an earlier submission deadline to provide greater opportunity for the student chapters to have funding if they plan to complete a project in the Fall semester vs the Spring semester,
    - submitting a poster presentation to be presented at the annual conference,

- school/personal funding to send at least 1 school representative to present the poster during the specified timeslot,
- and deadline instructions upfront for all items to be submitted to be considered completed.
  - We plan to send reminders in the Spring about a month before the stated due date to ensure completion of the project and items are submitted by 30April2023.
- We received a total of 7 applications this year by the 15Oct2022 deadline and only one chapter met the minimum eligibility criteria and submitted all the necessary items to be considered for the intital review.
  - We elected to extend the deadline with a one week grace period to complete the necessary tasks/items to be eligible with a completed application by 22Oct2022.
- Congratulatory emails were sent to 7 student chapters and their faculty advisors on 24Oct2022.
- Winners selected with the awardees addresses that had been verified was reported to Nena on 26Oct2022
- Grant checks issued to awardees on 1Nov2022.

Sara Bruner, the CPFI Regional Directors Coordinator (RDC), would like to report the following:

- In the 2022-2023 year we have 7 regional directors, including the regions Mid-Atlantic, Southeast, South-Atlantic, Great Lakes, Central Plains, Southwest, and North-Pacific.
  - These individuals have worked hard to increase participation in events this semester such as See You at the Pole and the Global Missions Health Conference. We are about to begin Operation Christmas Child shoebox collections across the nation for our 4th annual OCC competition between the CPFI school chapters.
- We have 86 chapters that are listed as ‘active’. Of these chapters,
  - 42 schools have completed their chapter update form this fall semester.
  - 27 chapters have not updated their form since 2020.
  - 19 chapters have not updated their form between 2011 and 2019.
  - 47 chapters have not updated since the 2011-2012 school year (these are chapters that have not been established).

### Future Goals

Our goals for the student ministry moving forward:

- Review the student awards deadline and document as well as work with the NSC publicist to “advertise” for submissions in the earlier part of the Spring semester.
- Streamline the role of the SCAC and fill in any gap areas.
- Compile a list of all standing documents utilized by student chapters.
- Clarify if there is an archive where records are kept and create one if it does not exist: e.g. all forms, student chapter bylaws that have been submitted, etc.
