CPFI Educational Affairs Committee Report November 11, 2024

Various members of the Educational Affairs Committee have worked to prepare for the annual conference in May of 2025; a great deal of work has been accomplished. A thorough review of the conference evaluations from the last three years has taken place to help better understand audience members' feedback. Helpful suggestions were collected from these evaluations including topics to be considered as well as speakers who could add to the value of the conference.

Further, a list of past, present, and future CPFI speakers has been assembled. This list has been shared with CPFI and NSC leadership to assist in simplifying the process of identifying high quality speakers for educational events such as the annual conference, prayer breakfasts, CE sessions, etc.

A working draft of the 2025 annual conference has been assembled and is proposed to have up to 13.25 hours of continuing education. Similar to years past, audience members will be able to participate in optional continuing education on Saturday afternoon or take a few hours to relax.

A couple of new individuals have been added to this year's conference line up. Many familiar faces will return this year as well. The conference is again slated to kick off on Thursday with a strong missions focus. As highlighted in the conference evaluations, a pain CE as well as a law/ethics CE are planned for this year.

Dr. Laswell will be unable to join us this year, so it is unlikely that the "Saline Process" will be available this year. We are excited to have Dr. Frame share this year on pharmacist intervention in wide-spread the human-trafficking problem that is plaguing the US, however.

The CPFI Executive Board of Directors directed this committee to investigate a remote option for the 2024 conference. At the annual conference, a basic live stream was available for a couple of sessions. Effort is underway to identify an individual(s) who can fully produce these sessions online. Further exploration in this area is pending.
