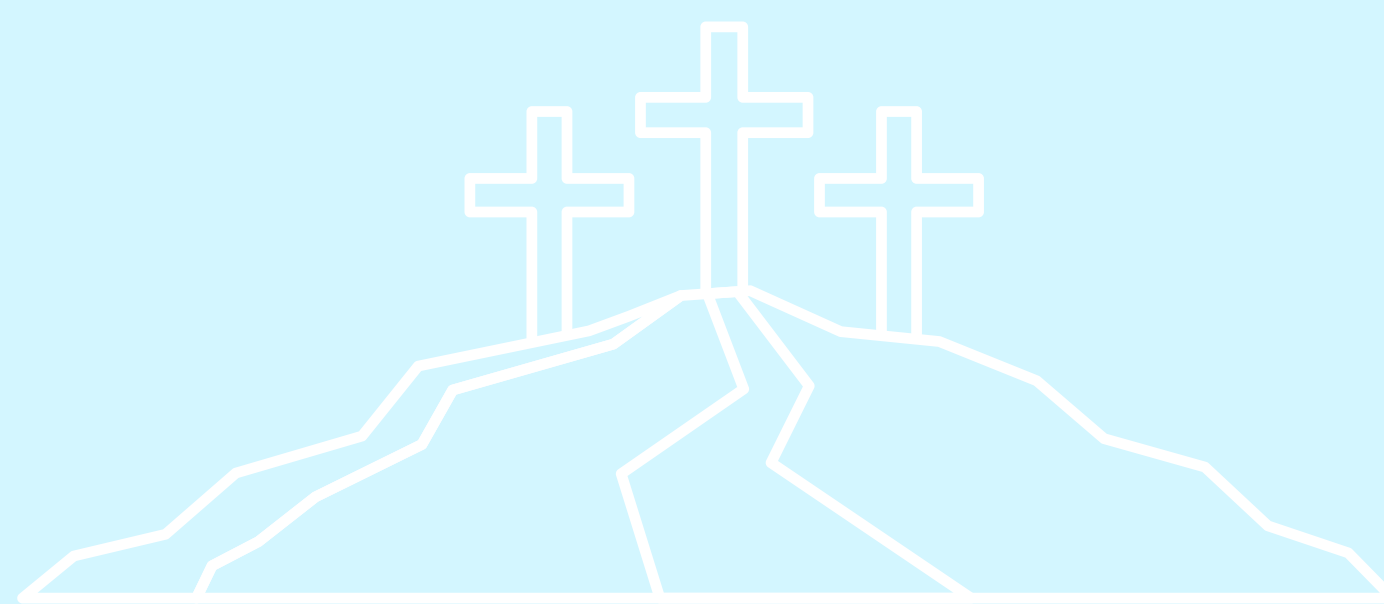

A LOOK BACK AT THE PAST!

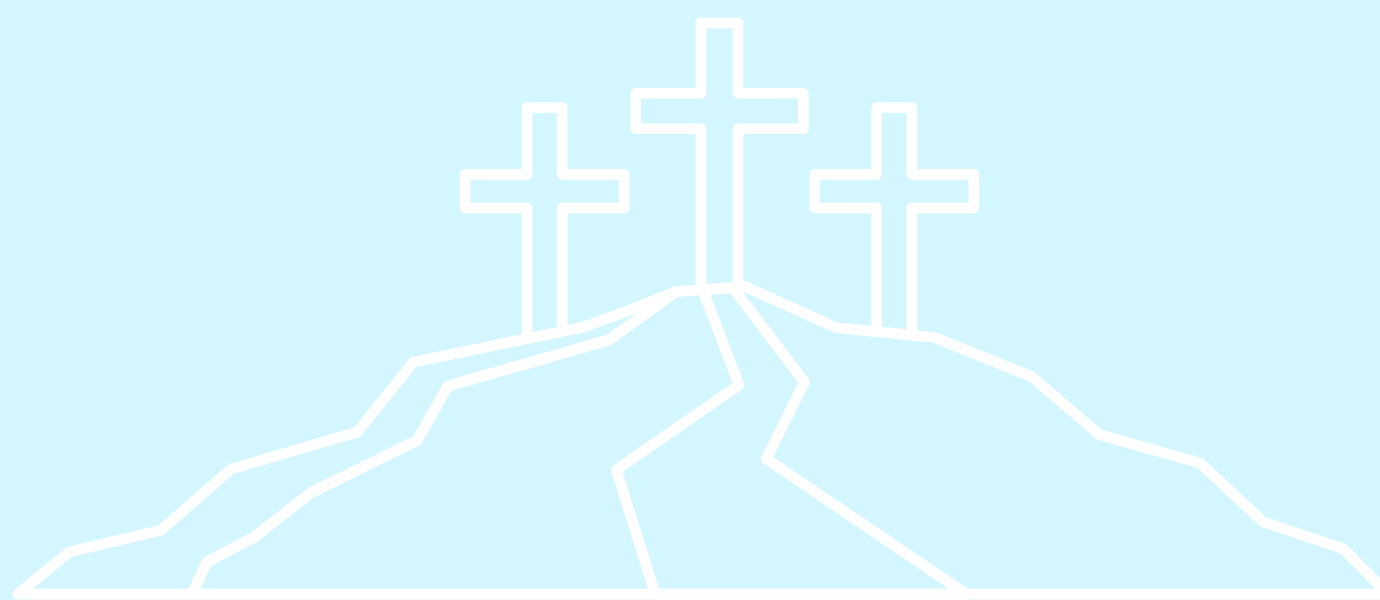

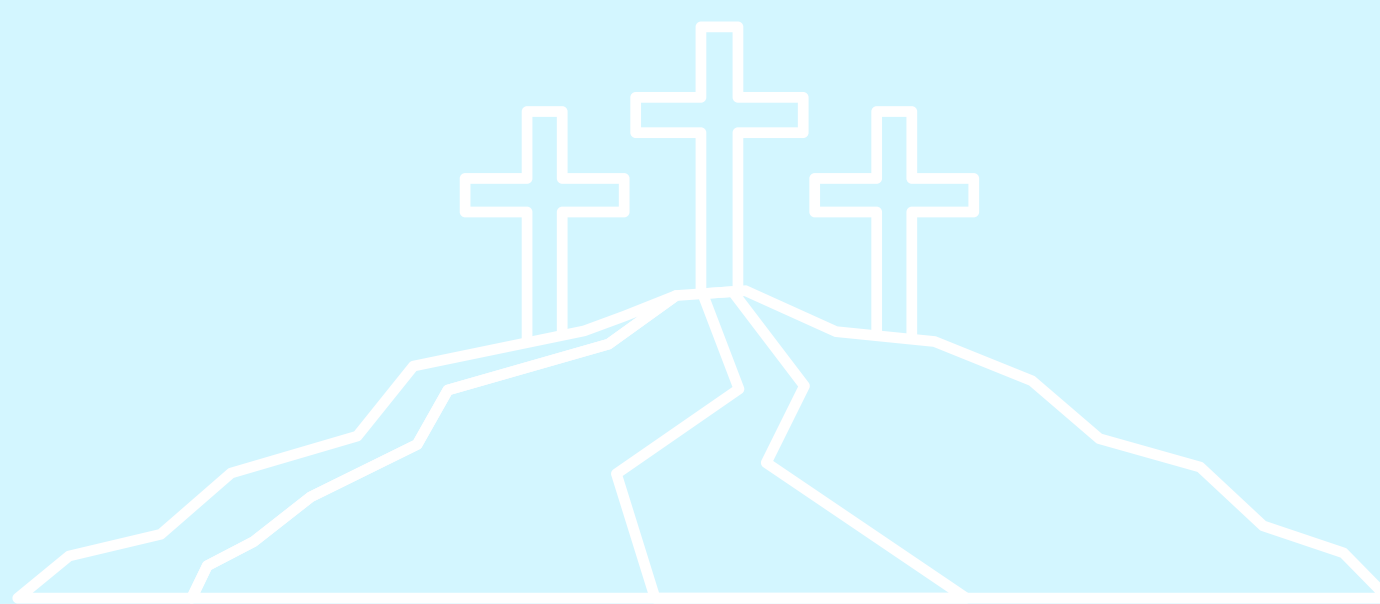

REMINDER, RENEW YOUR MEMBERSHIP!

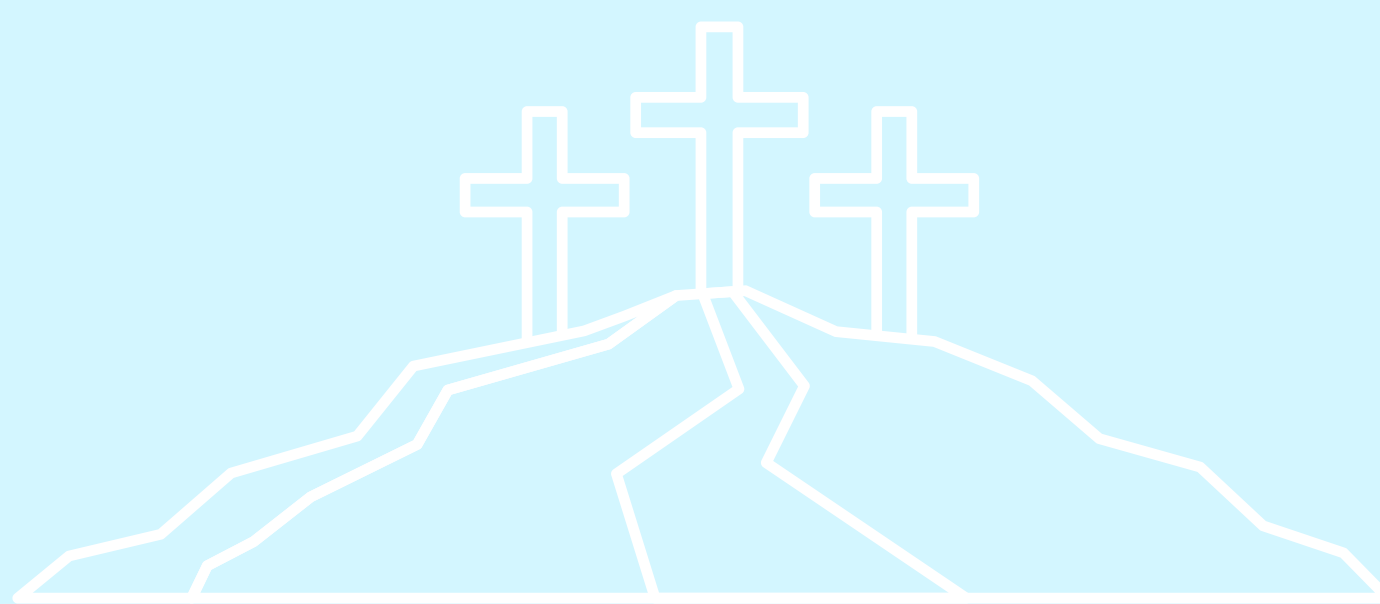


Current Student Members:

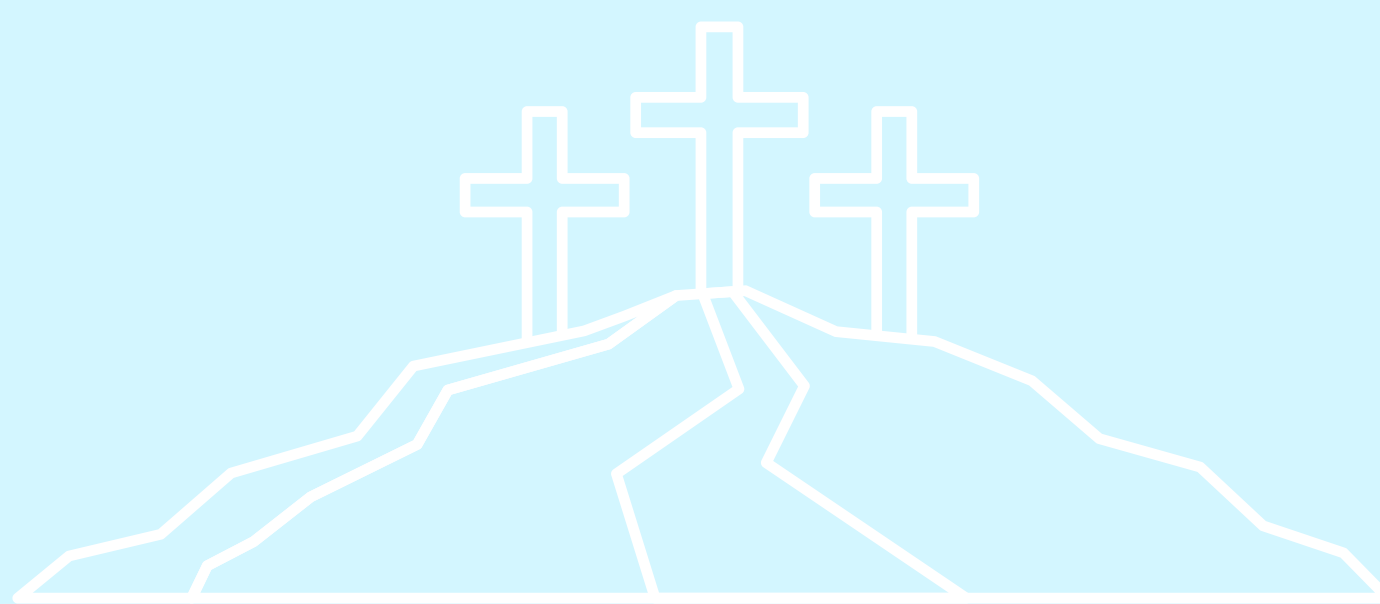
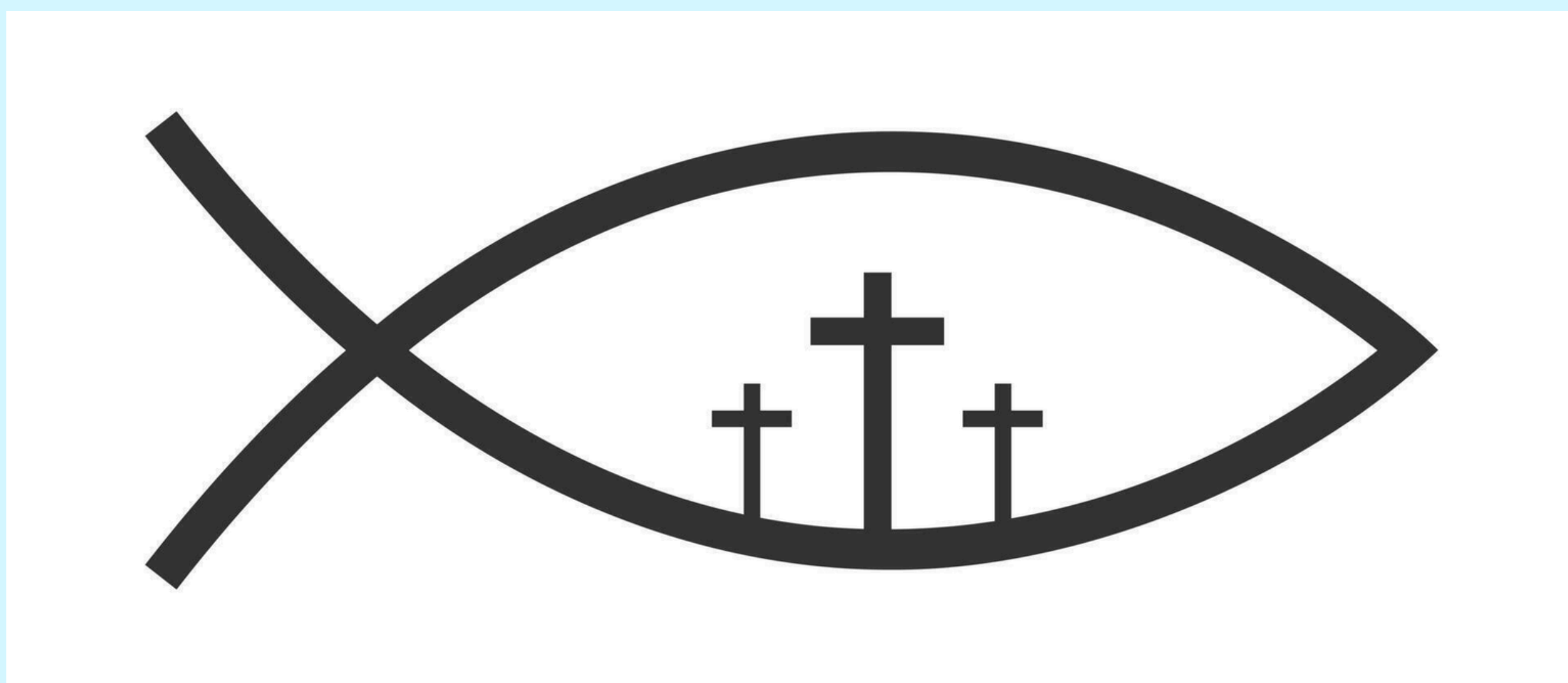


HANDS & FEET GRANT REMINDER!
