The CPFI chapter at California Northstate University, College of Pharmacy (CNUCOP) volunteers at different health fairs and community outreach events throughout the year. One of the outreach events during this year's Fall 2015 semester included Operation Christmas Child (OCC) initiated by CPFI Student Chapter at CNUCOP. This is the second year CNUCOP participated in OCC and achieved another successful outcome.

From October 26th to November 16th, student pharmacists brought gift-wrapped shoeboxes filled with gifts for children and placed them at the designated OCC decorated wall on campus.
